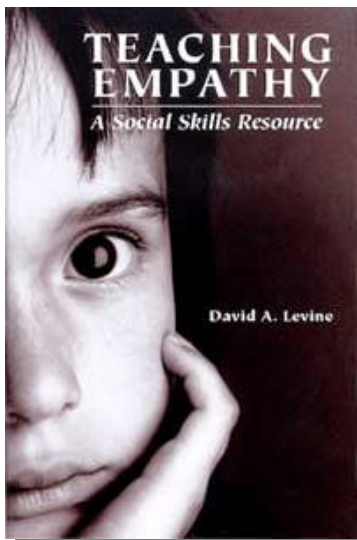
Dealing With Bullying and Peer Pressure
